

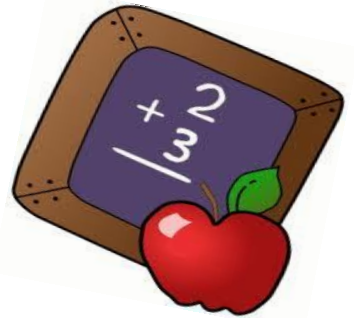
# JONES JOURNAL
